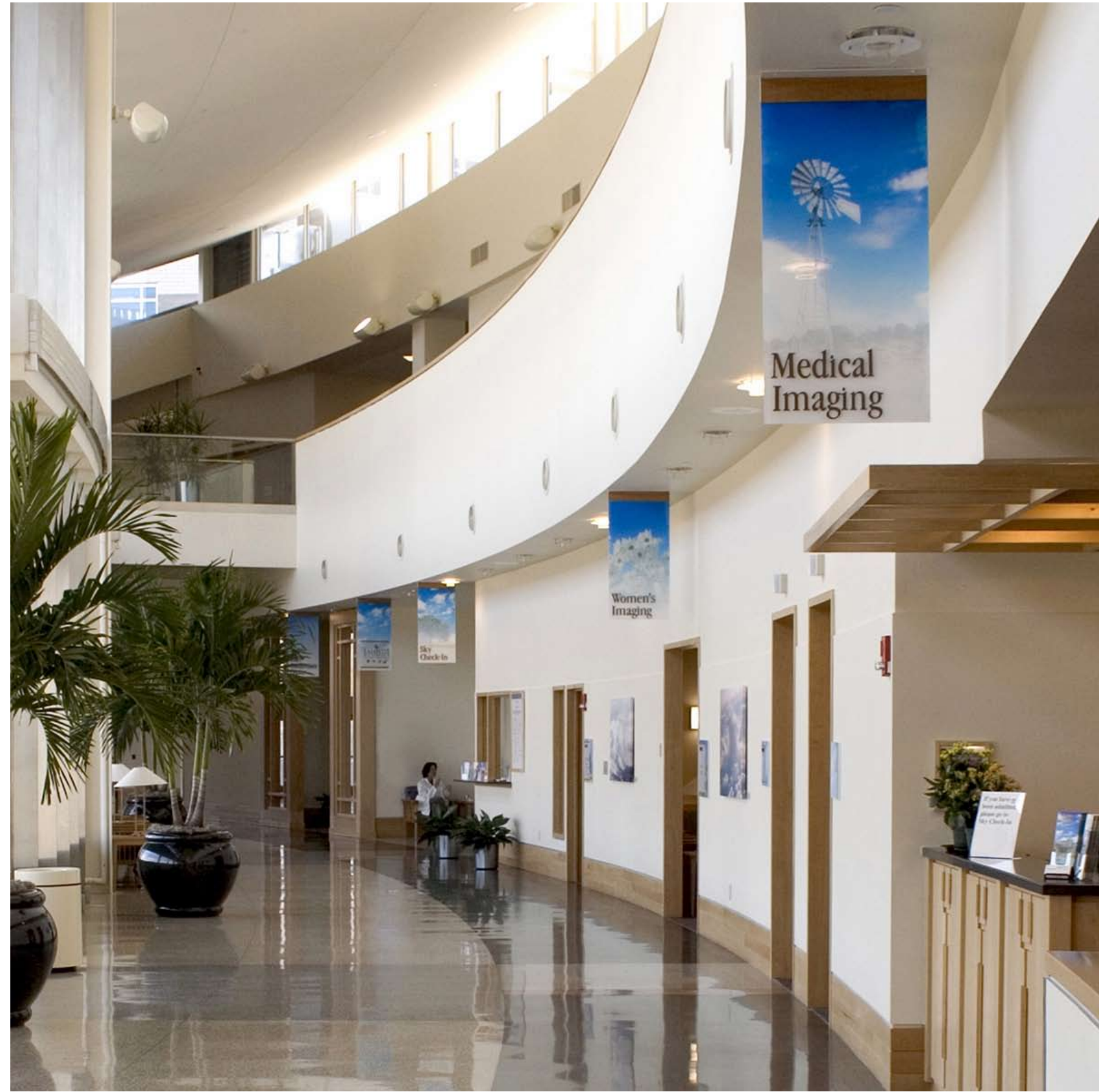

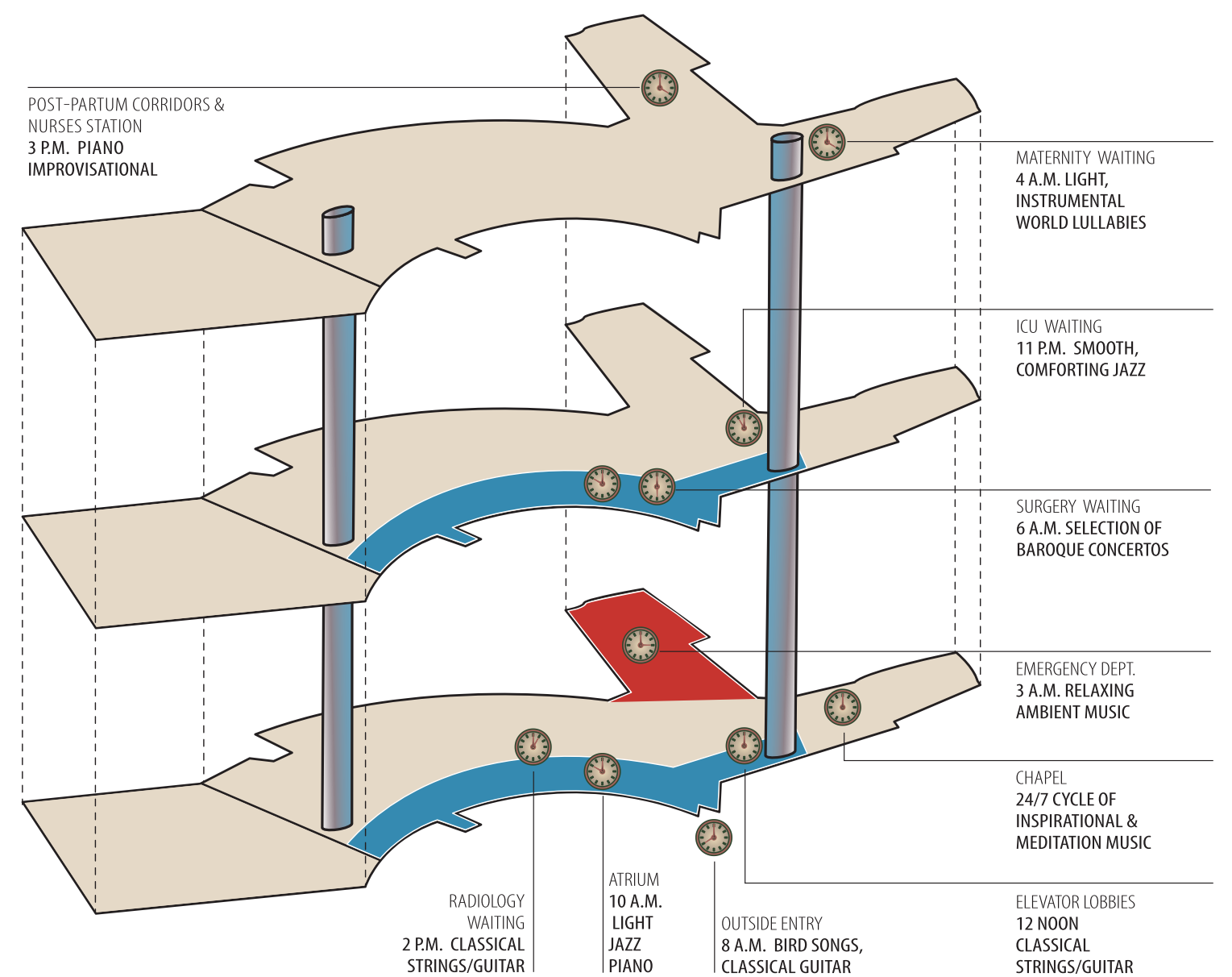


As one walks through the environment, there are several different aural experiences. Birds and nature sounds in the main hospital entryway give way to classical piano music in the lobby.



Exempla Good Samaritan Medical Center implemented 12 unique Harmonic Healthcare® programs for areas throughout the campus – from outside rock speakers to the elevator lobbies and all public spaces between.

A major challenge involved the atrium that has ceilings over 40 feet high with open air spaces on the second and third floors. This created a need to fill a large volume with sound in the atrium without intruding on the waiting areas on higher floors adjacent to the atrium space.



Visitors passing through the atrium are welcomed with appropriately designed music and volume levels. Designed music programs for waiting areas are based on the room acoustics, time of day used and the patient population.
